WHEREAS, there is also a felt need to equip the seven (7) top ranking officials of the Division of City Schools with a service motor vehicle each in order to enhance their mobility and to facilitate among others their supervision of the hundreds of elementary and secondary public schools distantly situated throughout the vast expanse of Quezon City.
