A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. SP-2259, S-2003, ENTITLED, "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY THOUSAND PESOS (P 20,000.00) TO EACH SURVIVING WIDOW OR HEIR OF DECEASED WAR VETERANS OF QUEZON CITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING BURIAL EXPENSES."

WHEREAS, Article XVI, Section 7 of the 1987 Constitution mandates that the State shall provide immediate and adequate care, benefits and other forms of assistance to war veterans and war veterans of military campaign, their surviving spouses and orphans;

WHEREAS, in recognition of the heroic and patriotic services rendered to our country by the surviving military veterans of Quezon City, it is fitting that they be accorded and granted financial assistance in time of their death in order that they may have a decent and honorable burial thereby perpetuating the memory of their sacrifices, ideals and deeds they had fought for;

WHEREAS, the prohibitive cost of burial expenses prevailing this day which continue to escalate will surely create a big problem financially to the surviving widows or heirs of the deceased veterans being themselves suffering from financial constraint or poverty.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to amend, as it does hereby amend, Resolution No. SP-2259, S-2003, to read as follows, "A Resolution authorizing the City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to grant financial assistance in the amount of Twenty Thousand Pesos (P20,000.00) to each surviving widow or heir of deceased war veterans who are legitimate members of the Veterans Federation of the Philippines (VFP) who are bonafide residents of Quezon City for at least five (5) years prior to the death and allocating the necessary funds for the purpose thereof to be taken from any available funds of the City."
