RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2556**, S-2004

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE SPECIAL INVESTIGATION COMMITTEE ON ADMINISTRATIVE CASES AGAINST ELECTIVE BARANGAY OFFICIALS IN ADMINISTRATIVE CASE NO. 13-03, ENTITLED, "RENATO B. AGITO, COMPLAINANT -VERSUS-PUNONG BARANGAY BERNARDO "ADO" SANCHEZ, RESPONDENT" OF BARANGAY KAUNLARAN.

WHEREAS, presented for investigation, hearing and recommendation before the Special Investigation Committee on Administrative Cases Against Elective Barangay Officials of the Quezon City Council pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, or the Local Government Code of 1991, is a verified complaint for disciplinary action in Administrative Case No. 13-03, entitled: "Renato B. Agito, Complainant-versus-Punong Barangay Bernardo "Ado" Sanchez, Respondent" of Barangay Kaunlaran,

WHEREAS, the issue having been joined and the parties have presented their respective evidence pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-798, S-2000, and the applicable rules and regulations, with the pertinent provisions of the Rules on Evidence and Civil Procedures of the Rules of Court as the supplementary rules, and in keeping with the paramount interest of justice and fair play, the committee rendered a report, a copy is attached, the dispositive portion of which is quoted as follows:

"In light of the foregoing, the Committee finds the Respondent, Punong Barangay Bernardo "Ado" Sanchez guilty as charged of misconduct in office. This Committee respectfully recommends that the administrative penalty of SUSPENSION for a period of ONE (1) MONTH, with forfeiture of his benefits during such period of suspension, be imposed on Respondent. No pronouncement is being made as to Respondent Ms. Concordia Palacio who is an appointive barangay official and therefore outside the jurisdiction of this Committee."

NOW, THEREFORE,


