RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2557**, 2004

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE SPECIAL INVESTIGATION COMMITTEE ON ADMINISTRATIVE CASES AGAINST ELECTIVE BARANGAY OFFICIALS IN ADMINISTRATIVE CASE NO. 28-03, ENTITLED, "MS. SUSAN SANDEJAS GOMEZ, COMPLAINANT -VERSUS- PUNONG BARANGAY VIRGILIO S. FERRER II AND KAGAWAD CLARO N. LORREDO, RESPONDENTS" OF BARANGAY UP VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, presented for investigation, hearing and recommendation before the Special Investigation Committee on Administrative Cases Against Elective Barangay Officials of the Quezon City Council pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, or the Local Government Code of 1991, is a verified complaint for disciplinary action in Administrative Case No. 28-03, entitled, "Ms. Susan Sandejas Gomez, Complainant -versus- Punong Barangay Virgilio S. Ferrer II and Kagawad Claro Lorredo, Respondents" of Barangay UP Village;

WHEREAS, the issues having been joined and the parties have presented their respective evidence pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-798, S-2000, and the applicable rules and regulations, with the pertinent provisions of the Rules and Evidence and Civil Procedures of the Rules of Court as the suppletory rules, and in keeping with the paramount interest of justice and fair play, the Committee rendered a report, a copy is attached, the dispositive portion of which is quoted, as follows:

"IN VIEW OF THE FOREGOING, this Committee finds no sufficient evidence for the Respondents Punong Barangay Virgilio S. Ferrer II and Kagawad Claro N. Lorredo to be convicted of the charges of Malversation of Public and Private Funds and Graft and Corruption filed against them and therefore the case against them is hereby DISMISSED."


