RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2558**S-2004

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE SPECIAL INVESTIGATION COMMITTEE ON ADMINISTRATIVE CASES AGAINST ELECTIVE BARANGAY OFFICIALS IN ADMINISTRATIVE CASE NO. 39-03, ENTITLED, "RENATO B. AGITO, COMPLAINANT -VERSUS- PUNONG BARANGAY BERNARDO "ADO" SANCHEZ, RESPONDENT" OF BARANGAY KAUNLARAN.

WHEREAS, presented for investigation, hearing and recommendation before the Special Investigation Committee on Administrative Cases Against Elective Barangay Officials of the Quezon City Council pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, or the Local Government Code of 1991, is a verified complaint for disciplinary action in Administrative Case No. 39-03, entitled: "Renato B. Agito, Complainant -versus- Punong Barangay Bernardo "Ado" Sanchez, Respondent" of Barangay Kaunlaran;

WHEREAS, the issues having been joined and parties have presented their respective evidence pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-798, S-2000, and the applicable rules and regulations, with the pertinent provisions of the Rules on Evidence and Civil Procedures of the Rules of Court as the suppletory rules, and in keeping with the paramount interest of justice and fair play, the Committee rendered a report, a copy is attached, the dispositive portion of which is quoted, as follows:

"In light of the foregoing, the Committee finds the Respondent, Barangay Captain Bernardo "Ado" Sanchez guilty as charged for the illegal sale of questioned vehicles because the proper procedure in the disposal of unserviceable property was not followed according to the rules laid down by law. It is most respectfully recommended that the administrative penalty of SUSPENSION for period of ONE (1) MONTH, with forfeiture of his benefits during such period of suspension be imposed on respondent."

WHEREAS, finding the report and the recommendation of the Committee to be supported by sufficient and incontrovertible evidence, the City Council has confirmed/approved the same during its Regular Session.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to confirm and approve, as it does hereby confirm and approve, the report and recommendation of the Special Investigation Committee on Administrative Cases Against Elective Barangay Officials in Administrative Case No. 39-03, entitled, "Renato B. Agito, Complainant - versus- Punong Barangay Bernardo "Ado" Sanchez, Respondent" of Barangay Kaunlaran, constituting as it does in the report as its DECISION, pursuant to Section 66 of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to authorize the City Secretary to serve a copy of this Resolution and the Committee report to all parties concerned including the City Mayor, the City Vice Mayor, the DILG City Director and the Chief of Barangay Operations Center, all of Quezon City, for their information, proper guidance, convenient reference and/or appropriate action.


