*A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1491, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY GRADE OF ALL PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS FROM SALARY GRADE 10 TO 22 AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR.*

*WHEREAS, House Bill No. 1491, otherwise known as "An Act Increasing the Salary Grade of all Public School Teachers from Salary Grade 10 to 22 and Providing Funds Therefor", has been filed before the House of Representatives by Honorable Carmelo Lazatin from the First District of Pampanga;*

*WHEREAS, at present, the public school teachers in the primary and secondary level are receiving a minimum of Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Three Pesos (P10,933.00) with a Salary Grade of 10 based on the adjusted salary of Ten Percent (10%) increase being implemented by the government as of July 2007;*

*WHEREAS, considering the higher cost of living today the said salary remains to be insufficient to defray the expenses of daily sustenance of their beloved families;*


WHEREAS, the aforesaid House Bill is intended to address the welfare of public school teachers, hoping to probably stop the increasing number of migration of teachers abroad;

WHEREAS, in order to truly address the alarming predicament and the incessant dilemma facing the teaching profession concerning teaching abroad, hence, necessitating the expression of support for the enactment of the aforesaid House Bill.

NOW, THEREFORE,




