*WHEREAS, the said program is an implementation of the Department of Health's (DOH) nationwide program addressing the proliferation of measles infecting our vulnerable children;*


WHEREAS, there is a need to bring the said health services to the grass root level so as to fully provide the needed medical treatment and to truly achieve the aforesaid purpose;
