A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SENATE BILL NO. 1826, ENTITLED "AN ACT PROMOTING THE FULL REALIZATION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISIONS ON SOCIAL JUSTICE AND THE RIGHT TO HEALTH THROUGH THE STRENGHTENING OF A COMPREHENSIVE FREE VACCINATION AND IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM FOR FILIPINO INFANTS AND CHILDREN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government is mandated to formulate legislative measures which aims to promote and protect the welfare of its constituency;

WHEREAS, one of the thrusts of our national government, particularly the Department of Health, is to provide for free the following vaccinations and immunizations for infants and children: Hepatitis B, DPT (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, H. Influenza type B (HiB), Polio, Rotavirus, MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) and Varicella (chicken pox);
