*WHEREAS, the Quezon City government is mandated to formulate legislative measures which aims to promote and protect the welfare of its constituency;*

*WHEREAS, one of the thrusts of our national government, particularly the Department of Health, is to provide for free the following vaccinations and immunizations for infants and children: Hepatitis B, DPT (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, H. Influenza type B (HiB), Polio, Rotavirus, MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) and Varicella (chicken pox);*


