RESOLUTION NO. SP- **4237** S-2008
(PR2008-226)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF FOGGING AND FUMIGATION IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE OPEN SPACES AND OTHER PLACES, FOR THE CONTROL AND/OR ERADICATION OF MOSQUITOES CARRYING DENGUE IN VARIOUS BARANGAYS, COMPRISING THE SECOND DISTRICT OF THIS CITY THE FUND FOR THE USE THEREOF SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE MAINTENANCE AND OTHER OPERATING EXPENSES (MOOE) OF THE PROPONENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION TWO HUNDRED FORTY NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED NINETY PESOS ONLY (P 2,249,690.00).

WHEREAS, Sections 16 and 17 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that, "each local government unit ensures the efficient delivery of basic services including among others adequate health and social services to its constituents";

WHEREAS, there is now a widespread and alarming complaints coming from various barangays on the sudden increase of insect pests especially the most annoying disease-carrying mosquitoes and flies;

WHEREAS, the mosquitoes that transmit dengue live among humans and breed in places where there is stagnant water – in old tires; used oil drums, flower pots and uncovered water containers inside the house;

WHEREAS, the incidence of diseases and sickness due to the insect bites are noted to be common and increasing everyday;


WHEREAS, with the occurrence of the outbreak of calamities or any form of emergency situations, there is a need to immediately institute preventive measures to address the same, which include the conduct of fogging and fumigation in public and private open spaces and other places for the control and/or eradication of mosquitoes carrying dengue;

WHEREAS, it is the principal obligation of every local government unit to preserve the safety and economic convenience of the inhabitants and to minimize the danger brought about by dengue.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the conduct of fogging and fumigation in public and private open spaces and other places, for the control and/or eradication of mosquitoes carrying dengue in various barangays, comprising the Second District of this City. The fund for the use thereof shall be taken from the Maintenance and other Operating Expenses (MOOE) of the proponent, in the amount of Two Million Two Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Six Hundred Ninety Pesos Only (P 2,249,690.00).


