RESOLUTION NO. SP-**A 271**, S-2008

A RESOLUTION URGING THE SANITATION DIVISION UNDER THE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO PERIODICALLY INSPECT ALL FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS AND BUSINESSES ENGAGED IN THE MANUFACTURING, PROCESSING, STORING, SELLING AND SERVING OF LOCAL FOODS FOR PUBLIC PATRONAGE OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City government to safeguard the health and welfare of its citizenry from hazardous practices of handling, preparation and selling local food contaminated with bacteria and viruses harmful to human health;

WHEREAS, numerous reports has struck the attention of the public concerning the rampant violation of our local ordinances and most importantly the Sanitation Code of the Philippines committed by small scale local food manufacturers plying their trade in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, there is a need to regularly inspect all food establishments and businesses engaged in the manufacturing, processing, storing, selling and serving of local foods for public patronage operating within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City so as to strictly implement local sanitation standards, and existing policies and provisions of the law;


WHEREAS, pursuant to the mandate given to the Sanitation Division of the Quezon City Health Department, the Division is hereby tasked to work in close coordination with the Business Permits and Licensing Office with regard to the securing and renewal of business permits and to recommend possible suspension or revocation of business permits issued to food establishments and businesses engaged in the manufacturing, processing, storing, selling and serving of local foods for public patronage operating within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City which are found to have violated the Sanitation Code of Quezon City.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the Sanitation Division under the Quezon City Health Department to periodically inspect all food establishments and businesses engaged in the manufacturing, processing, storing, selling and serving of local foods for patronage operating within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Sanitation Division under the Quezon City Health Department must work in close coordination with the Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) with regards to the securing and renewal of business permits and to recommend possible revocation of said business permits.
