

WHEREAS, Senatorial Drive corner Congressional Avenue, Congressional Village North in Quezon City, connecting April Street and Congressional Avenue, spans only 100 meters;

WHEREAS, renaming Senatorial Drive to April Street promotes contiguity, aesthetic unity, practicality and convenience for the residents of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 13 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Quezon City is authorized to change the name of city roads within its territorial jurisdiction.
