**A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE JUNE 8, 2009 VICTIMS OF FIRE THAT BURNED THE RESIDENTIAL HOUSES OF TWO HUNDRED THIRTEEN (213) FAMILIES AT P. FLORENTINO STREET, BARANGAY SANTO DOMINGO, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE SOURCE OF FUND THEREOF.**
