RESOLUTION NO. SP- 5068, S-2011

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO PHOENIX PETROLEUM PHILIPPINES, INC., FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A GASOLINE AND SERVICE STATION LOCATED ALONG ROOSEVELT AVENUE, BARANGAY SAN ANTONIO, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Phoenix Petroleum Philippines, Inc. is applying for a Special Use Permit from the Quezon City Council for the construction and operation of a gasoline and service station located along Roosevelt Avenue, Barangay San Antonio, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Article VII, Section 2 of Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000 and its implementing rules and regulations, a Special Use Permit is required for this project;

WHEREAS, the petitioner has complied with the requirements for their application for the issuance of a Special Use Permit and that Barangay San Antonio and their residents therein interposed no objection to the project;

NOW, THEREFORE,
