A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF EXCEPTION TO KARL ALEXANDER TINIO COTAOCO, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SIX (6) UNITS THREE (3)-STOREY RESIDENTIAL BUILDING LOCATED AT NUMBER 32 MATIPID STREET, BARANGAY SIKATUNA VILLAGE QUEZON CITY, ALLOWING DEVIATION FROM THE RESTRICTIONS OF THE QUEZON CITY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 
NOW, THEREFORE,
