WHEREAS, the Philippine Youth Games – Batang Pinoy, created through Executive Order No. 44, serves as the national sports competition program for children envisioned to address the need for the comprehensive grassroots sports program centered on values formation inherent in the practice of sports and play:

WHEREAS, Batang Pinoy is organized in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd), Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), and the Leagues of Provinces, Cities, Municipalities and Barangays;

WHEREAS, the Philippines Sports Commission-Philippine Olympic Committee Batang Pinoy National Finals for children 13 years and under was held in Bacolod City from January 28 to February 1, 2014, 1 Res. No. SP- 5973 S-2014 Page -2- PRISCC-377

WHEREAS, a total of 21 sports were contested including arnis, athletics, badminton, basketball, chess, cycling, dancesport, futsal, gymnastics, karatedo, lawn tennis, sepak takraw, softball, swimming, table tennis, taekwondo, triathlon, volleyball, weightlifting, wrestling and wushu;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government entered 66 athletes in 10 different events, and garnered the highest number of medals — twenty nine (29) gold, twenty two (22) silver and nineteen (19) bronze, among 128 local government units;

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper for the City government to recognize and commend the relentless hardwork and determination of Quezon City athletes who brought distinct honor to the City by emerging as the most bemedalled delegation in the recently concluded Batang Pinoy National Finals.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to extend, as it does hereby extend the sincerest and heartfelt congratulations and commendation of the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M.
