WHEREAS, Rizal Gaming Corporation is a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines with the principal office at Tandang Sora, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR) granted Rizal Gaming Corporation an authority to operate an E-Bingo Boutique where said games may be played;

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Council, through a Resolution, may grant Special Permit or licenses;

WHEREAS, Rizal Gaming Corporation, through its representative Mr. Alejandro P. Alonte, seeks to operate an E-Bingo Boutique in Quezon City which necessarily need a Special Permit from the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, the authority to operate an E-Bingo Boutique granted herein shall be subject to the following limitations;

 The holding of E-Bingo Boutique shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;

b. The operation of E-Bingo Boutique shall not include the playing of games not related to or other than bingo;

c. The operator is enjoined to prohibit individuals below 18 years of age from playing in the above-mentioned games.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant a Special Permit to Rizal Gaming Corporation to operate an E-Bingo Boutique in Tandang Sora, Quezon City, subject to the Rules and Regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that Rizal Gaming Corporation shall remit to the City Treasurer a franchise fee of three percent (3%) of the gross revenue of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasurer during the lifetime of this measure.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the authority herein granted shall be for a period of two (2) years and may be renewed by the City Council.
