RESOLUTION NO. SP- **5993**, S-2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE BY THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, THROUGH THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, OF ONE (1) UNIT OF MOTOR VEHICLE AMOUNTING TO EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (PHP800,000.00), TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE FUNDS OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR INTENDED FOR THE OPERATION OF THE QUEZON CITY HUMAN MILK BANK UNDER THE QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL.

WHEREAS, the first Quezon City Human Milk Bank will be housed and supervised by the Quezon City General Hospital;

WHEREAS, for the purpose of efficient collection and transportation of Human Milk to and from the Quezon City Human Milk Bank, a service vehicle is requested;
