**WHEREAS**, Commonwealth Act No. 502: An Act to Create Quezon City was signed into law on October 12, 1939 by President Manuel L. Quezon who envisioned "a capital city that, politically, shall be the seat of the national government; aesthetically, the showplace of the nation - a place where thousands of people will come to visit as the epitome of the culture and the spirit of the country; socially, a dignified concentration of human life aspirations, endeavors and achievements; and economically, a productive, self-contained community." *WHEREAS, in celebration of the 75<sup>th</sup> Foundation Anniversary of Quezon City on October 12, 2014, it is essential for our students to reminisce and commemorate the events that have contributed to the historical, cultural and artistic heritage, and progress of the City;*

*WHEREAS, for consistency the book entitled "The City With A Soul", authored by Ma. Luisa T. Comagay shall serve as the main source reference about the history and culture of Quezon City;*

*WHEREAS, education programs promoting Quezon City's history, culture, and arts aim to increase student's appreciation and instill pride for the City.*

**NOW, THEREFORE,**


