A RESOLUTION RESPECTIFULLY RECOMMENDING TO THE PHILIPPINE POSTAL CORPORATION, THROUGH THE POSTMASTER GENERAL AND CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER, MARIA JOSEFINA M. DE LA CRUZ, AND THE NATIONAL HISTORICAL COMMISSION OF THE PHILIPPINES TO EFFECT THE ISSUANCE OF A COMMEMORATIVE STAMP IN HONOR OF THE 100TH FOUNDING ANNIVERSAFY OF THE IGLESIA MI CRISTO.

WHEREAS, in recognition of the immense contribution of the Iglesia Ni Cristo in propagating Christian faith and social unity in its 100 years of existence, the Philippine Government - through the Philippine Postal Corporation - should bestow the honor to the Iglesia Ni Cristo through the issuance of a commemorative stamp as to etched in the national consciousness the milestone in its glorious history.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to recommend, as it does hereby respectfully recommend to the Philippine Postal Corporation, through The Postmaster General and Chief Executive Officer, Maria Josefina M. De La Cruz, and the National Historical Commission of the Philippines to effect the issuance of a Commemorative Stamp in honor of the 100th founding anniversary of the Iglesia Ni Cristo.
