RESOLUTION NO. SP. 6015 S-2014

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT REPRESENTED BY THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, AND THE NATIONAL FOOD AUTHORITY REPRESENTED BY ITS PROVINCIAL MANAGER, ENGINEER LEMIUEL R. PAGAYUNAN, TO ALLOW THE PURCHASE OF RICE ON CREDIT FOR RELIEF OPERATIONS WHENEVER A STATE OF CALAMITY IS DECLARED EITHER BY THE LOCAL LEGISLATIVE BODIES OR THE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT.

While EAS on June 25, 2013 the National Food Authority, represented by Engr. Leanel R. Pagayunan, Provincial Manager, and the City Government of Churon City, represented by Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, City Mayor, had entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to allow the purchase of rice on credit for relief operations whenever a State of Calamity is declared either by the local legislative bodies or the Office of the President. A photocopy of the MOA is hersto attached and made an integral part hereof.

WHEREAS, under Section 4.55 (b) (1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code 199), the city mayor shall represent the city in all its business transactions and right in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations; and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlangsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

WHEREAS, one of the powers conferred upon the city mayor under the said Code is to carry out such emergency measures as may be necessary during and in the aftermath of man-made and natural disasters and calamities;

WHEREAS, likewise, under Section 458 (1) (iv) of the same Code, the City Council may adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and in their return to productive livelihood following said events.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify the Memorandum of Agreement entered into by and between the Quezon City Government represented by the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, and the National Food Authority, represented by its Provincial Manager, Engr. Lemuel P. Pagayunan, to allow the purchase of rics on credit for relief operations whenever a state of calamity is declared either by the local legislative bodies or the Office of the President.
