A RESOLUTION GRANTING A SPECIAL PERMIT TO ALLPOINT LEISURE CORPORATION TO OPERATE A BINGO HALL AT MF, SM CITY STA. MESA, AURORA BOULEVARD, QUEZON CITY, FOR PURPOSES OF HOLDING BINGO GAMES SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPLYE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION.

WHEREAS, Allpoint Leisure Corporation is a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines with principal office at 3/F, SM City Sta. Mesa, Aurora Boulevard, Quezon City:

WHEREAS, the Philippine Amusement and Ganing Corporation (PAGCOR) granted Allpoint Leisure Corporation an authority to operate Bingo Hall where said games may be played;

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Council, through a Resolution, may grant Special Permits or licenses;

WHEREAS, Allpoint Leisure Corporation, through its representative Mr. Victor Joseph R. Lorenzo, suchs to operate a Bingo Hall in Quezon City which necessarily need a Special Permit from the Quezon City Council, 1

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant a Special Permit to Allpoint Leisure Corporation to operate a Ringo Hell at MF, SM City Sta. Mesa, Aur na Rouleward, Quezon City, for purposes of holding Ringo Games subject to the Rules and Regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the authority to operate a Bingo hall granted herein shall be subject to the following limitations:

- a. The holding of Bingo Hall shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations promulgated by PAGCCR;
- b. The operation of Bingo Hell shall not include the playing of games not related to or other than bingo;
- c. The operator is enjoined to prohibit individuals below 18 years of age from playing in the above-mentioned games

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, that Allpoint Leisure Corporation shall remit a franchise fee of three percent (3%) of the gross sales of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasurer during the lifetime of this measure.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the Special Permit to operate a bingo hall shall be for a period of two (2) years.
