BAUTISTA, AND THE DISTRICT DIRECTOR, QUEZON CITY POLICE DISTRICT (QCPD), TO CONSIDER THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COMMUNITY POLICE PRECINCT IN THE AREA OF TANDANG SORA TO BE LOCATED IN AN OPEN SPACE IN NAPOCOR VILLAGE, BARANGAY TANDANG SORA, DISTRICT 6, QUEZON CITY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, and the District Director, Quezon City Police District (QCPD), to consider the establishment of a Community Police Precinct in the area of Tandang Sora to be located in an open space in Napocor Village, Barangay Tandang Sora, District 6, Quezon City.


