A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. EAUTISTA TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE EURHAU OF EMMIGRATION (EI), REPRESENTED BY COMMISSIONER SUBGERED B. MISON, BY ALLOWING THE BI TO OCCUPY THE SECOND FLOOR OF THE NEW CIVIL REGISTRY BUILDING TO SERVE AS THE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF BI'S STUDENT DESK

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 285 provides the amended guidelines governing the entry and stay of foreign students in the Philippines and establishes on Inter-Agency Committee composed of the Commission on Higher Education (CHED). Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA), Department of Education (Depfed), Bureau of Immigration (BI), National Bureau of Investige for (NSI) and National Intelligence Coordinating Agency (NICA) to monitor, poordinate, assess and implement the provisions of E.O. No. 285; J. L.

WE'EREAS. E.O. No. 285 likewise directed the BI to create a Foreign Student Less that shall process and monitor: (1) applications for student visa conversion or extension; (2) applications for Special Study Permit; (3) applications for accreditation to accept foreign students by Higher Educational Institutions; (4) BI Clearance applications of foreign students; (5) and the activities of foreign students in the Philippines;

WEEPEAS, the duties and responsibilities of the B' Student Desk require its placemen, in a strategic location in Metro Manila for better public access and to support constant communication and coordination with the other members of the Inter-Egency Committee;

WHEFEAS, on 3 July 2014, Commissioner Siegfred B. Mison of the Bureau of Intenigration sent a latter request to the Honoral le City Mayor Herbert M. Bautista, requesting for the transfer of the BI Student Desk to the City Civil Registry Endling, Quezon City Half Compound:

WHEFEAS, the BL in consultation with the Queson City Government, determined that the relocation of the Bl Student Desk Office from its current position at Intramuros, Manila to Quezon City (1) provides better access by the public to Bl Student Desk services (2) promotes faster communication and coordination with the other members of the Inter-Agency Committee that are situated in Quezon City and (3) frees office space to expand existing offices at the Main Office,

WELFEEAS, as of 9 July 2014, the BI has the following data about foreigners residing and studying in Quezon City, to wit:

Total registered foreigners: 23, 588Total 9(f) Student Visc holders: 2, 930Total Holders of Special Litudy Permit : 1, 2001, 200Total Number of Accredited Schools: 191

WHATERAS, there exists a vacant office space measuring two hundred fifty five square meters (255 Sqm.) at the new Quezon City Civil Registry Building located at the Quezon City Hall Compound;

WHEREAS, the proposed Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) shall form an integral part of this Resolution. $\sqrt{\frac{1}{2}}$
