A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CITY VICE MAYOR, HONORABLE MA JOSEFINA "JOY" BELMONTE, TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT HEAD TO ESTABLISH A FIRST AID CLINIC AT THE LEGISLATIVE WING BUILDING OF QUEZON CITY HALL TO ACCOMMODATE CITY GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS, EMPLOYEES AND VISITORS NEED FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL ATTENTION.

WHEREAS, city officials and employees were clamoring for an accessible first aid services which they can depend on in case of emergency;

WHEREAS, to provide a first aid clinic at the legislative wing of city hall is more appropriate and beneficial to the employees because it can be utilized for purposes of preventive medical care and emergency cases since the City Health Department's office is located at the back of the city hall.

WHEREAS, the City Vice Mayor is hereby requested to provide a first Aid Clinic at the Legislative Wing of Quezon City Hall to accommodate city government official employees and visitors need for emergency;

WHEREAS, the person knowledgeable in the First-aid or acquired training in the field of medicine shall be assigned in said first Aid Clinic and the basic requirements and medicines needed thereat shall be supplied by the City Vice Mayor;

Josefina "Joy" Belmonte, to authorize the Health Department Head to establish a first aid clinic at the legislative wing building of Quezon City Hall to accommodate city government officials, employees and visitors need for emergency medical attention.
