A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO PURCHASE ONE (1) UNIT OF MOTOR VEHICLE IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED NINETY SIX THOUSAND PESOS (PHP596,000.00), INTENDED TO FACILITATE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS OF THE DIVISION OF CITY SCHOOLS OF QUEZON CITY TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE FUNDS OF THE OFFICE OF COUNCILOR JESUS MANUEL C. SUNTAY.

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WHEREAS, the Division of City Schools was recognized by the Department of Education, established primarily to exercise general supervision over both public and private elementary and secondary schools in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, to ensure that such function be fully performed by the said office, there is an imperative need to provide them the necessary motor vehicle;




WHEREAS, the Office of Councilor Jesus Manuel C. Santay desires to procure one (1) unit of All-Purpose Vehicle (APV) GA to be used for the aforesaid purposes, with the following general specifications:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to purchase one (1) unit of motor vehicle in the amount of Five Hundred Ninety Six Thousand Pesos (Php596,000.00), intended to facilitate the implementation of the programs and projects of the Division of City Schools of Quezon City, to be charged against the funds of the Office of Councilor Jesus Manuel C. Santay.
