RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6094**, S-2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE WINNING BIDDER/S FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP3,745,000.00), TO BE UTILIZED IN THE RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT PROGRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY.

WHEREAS, Section 22 (c) and 455 (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", requires prior authorization of the City Council before the local chief executive can enter into a contract in behalf of the local government unit;

WHEREAS, the Commission on Audit (COA) issued an Audit Observation Memorandum 2014-11-C (2013), citing as basis the Supreme Court decision in the case of Hon. Gabriel Quisumbing vs Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (G.R. No. 175527), requiring the City Council to give prior authorization to the city mayor before any expense / disbursement charged against a lump sum appropriation can be made;

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WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor is requesting for authorization from the Quezon City Council for the purchase of two (2) motor vehicles in the total amount of three million seven hundred forty five thousand pesos (PHP 3,745,000.00) to be used by the Department of Public Order and Safety on its Risk Reduction and Management Program, to wit:


