A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE QUEZON CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND EXPENDITURE PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014 IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED FORTY NINE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED PESOS (PHP249,461,600.00) TO FUND THE PROCUREMENT OF DRUGS, MEDICINES, MEDICAL, DENTAL, AND LABORATORY EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING ITS ACCESSORIES.

WHEREAS, since 2011, the Quezon City General Hospital Development Fund has an accrued balance of Two Hundred Forty Nine Million Four Hundred Sixty One Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (Php249,461,600.00);

WHEREAS, Republic Act 6548 requires the approval of the Quezon City Council to disburse the Hospital Development Fund to support the operational expenses, including the procurement of equipment and improvement of hospital facilities to increase the efficiency rating of the Quezon City General Hospital;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City General Hospital submitted its proposed Priority Development Program to improve its capacity to deliver quality health and medical care services for the residents and clients of the hospital:

WHEREAS, the program includes the procurement of drugs, medicines, and other laboratory supplies and equipment for the hospital. General maintenance, informational technology and communications expenses are also included in the Hospital Development Program;

WHEREAS, the Local Finance Committee attests that the surplus amount of Two Hundred Forty Nine Million Four Hundred Sixty One Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (Php249,461,600.00) is available for appropriation to support the Hospital Development Program of the Quezon City General Hospital.
