WHEREAS, to lessen the adverse impacts of said hazards and related disasters, the city government must institute some prevautionary measures through disaster preparedness by way of providing books or reading materials that will enhance the knowledge or understanding of the people, associable the weeth about disasters such as flood earthweite fire and the like;

WHENEAS, the books partaining to climate change and disaster preparedness are helpful and essential to students of elementary and high school as they would become more aware and prepared in the event of any disaster or any eventualities and other emergency situations;

WHEREAS, to make the said books accessible to students, it is imperative that all public elementary and high school libraries in Quezon City, as well as the city-owned library and its branches, be given copies thereof;

WHEREAS, Section 14 of Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010", provides that:

The DepEd, the CHSD, the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), in coordination with the OCD, the National Youth Commission (NYC), the DOST, the DENR, the DILG-BFP, the DOH, the DSWD and other relevant agencies, shall integrate disaster risk reduction and management education in the school cursicular of secondary and tertiary level of education, including the National Service Training Program (NSTP), whether private or public, technical-vocational indigenous learning, and out-of-school youth courses and programs xxxxx

WHEREAS, in DepEd Order No. 83, S-2011, Recretary Armin A. Luistro of the Department of Education, encourages the involvement of the students, their families and their communities in preparing for disasters as an effective method of raising their awareness about risk reduction.
