

WHEREAS, under Section 444 (4) of Republic Act No. 7150, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code", the Chief Executive's Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation is to ensure the delivery of basic services and the provision of adequate facilities as provided for under Section 17 of this code and, in addition hereto, shall:

- (i) Ensure that the construction and repair of roads and highways funded by the national government shall be, as far as practicable, carried out in a spatially contiguous manner and in coordination with the construction and repair of the roads and bridges of the city, and in the case of component cities, of the city and of the province; and
- (ii) Coordinate the implementation of technical services, including public works and infrastructure programs rendered by national offices in the case of highly urbanized and independent component cities, and by national and provincial offices in the case of component cities.


