RESOLUTION NO. SP- 6111 S-2014

A RESOLUTION URGING THE QUEZON CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL TO INSTITUTIONALIZE THE CONDUCT OF SEMI-ANNUAL SYNCHRONIZED EMERGENCY AND DISASTER DRILLS IN ALL SCHOOLS, SHOPPING MALLS, HOSPITALS, OFFICE BUILDINGS, AND RESIDENTIAL CONDOMINIUMS IN QUEZON CITY EVERY FIRST MONDAY OF MARCH AND FIRST MONDAY OF SEPTEMBER IN COORDINATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY AND THE QUEZON CITY FIRE DISTRICT, AND WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF GOVERNMENT HOSPITALS IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, it is the primary responsibility of concerned government agencies and instrumentalities to have documented emergency and preparedness plans that will guide and direct affected people on their proper actions and conduct in times of actual calamities.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the Quezon City Risk Reduction and Management Council to institutionalize the conduct of semi-annual synchronized emergency and disaster drills in all schools, shopping malls, hospitals, office buildings, and residential condominiums in Quezon City every first Monday of March and first Monday of September in coordination with the Department of Public Order and Safety and the Quezon City Fire District, and with the assistance of government hospitals in Quezon City.


