RESOLUTION HO. SP. 611 S-3024

A RESCLUTION URGING THE QUEZON CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL TO DISETTUTIONALIZE THE CONDUCT OF SEMI-ANNUAL SYNCHRONIZED EMERGENCY AND DISASTER DRILLS IN ALL SCHOOLS, SHOPPING MALLS, HOSPITALS, OFFICE BUILDINGS, AND RESIDENTIAL CONDOMINIUMS IN QUEZON CITY EVERY FIRST MONDAY OF MARCH AND FIRST MONDAY OF SEPTEMBER IN COORDINATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY AND THE QUEZON CITY FIRE LISTRICT, AND WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF GOVERNMENT HOSPITALS IN QUEZON CITY.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN RECHULAR MESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the Quezon City Risk Reduction and Management Council to institut analize the conduct of sensi-annual synchrorized emergency and disaster drills in all schools, shopping malls, he spitals, office buildings, and residential condominiums in Quezon City every first Manakay of March and first Manakay of September in coordination with the Department of Public Order and Safety and the Quezon City Fire District, and with the assistance of government hospitals in Quezon City.
