RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6119** S-2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR OF QUEZON CITY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OF AGREEMENT WITH THE WINNING BIDDER FOR THE PURCHASE OF A CONSTRUCTION AND HEAVY EQUIPMENT DECLECLOGER, FUNDED UNDER LUMP SUM APPROPRIATION (LOCAL RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT FUND) WITH AN AMOUNT OF TWENTY TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED FORTY FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP22,345,000.00).

WHEREAS, Section 356 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates that the procurement or acquisition of supplies and services by local government units (LGUs) shall be made through competitive public bidding;

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b) '1) (vi) of the same Code provides that the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf contracts or agreements upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod;

WHEREAS, the Commission on Audit (COA) issued an Audit Observation Memorandum 2014-11-C (2013), citing as basis the Supreme Court decision in the case of Hon. Gabriel Quisumbing vs. Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia (G.R. No. 175527), requiring the City Council to give prior authorization to the City Mayor before any expense/disbursement charged against a lump sum appropriation can be made;

WHEREAS, the City Budget Department certified that funds are available and chargeable against the lump sum appropriation of the Office of the City Mayor;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Department of Public Order and Safety (QC DPOS) is implementing the Risk Reduction Management Program, which aims to reduce the damage caused by natural hazard like earthquakes, floods, droughts, and cyclones, through an efficient prevention system;

WHEREAS, the City Engineering Department (CED) of Quezon City tasked to implement the declogging of rivers, creeks, canals and other waterways in connection with such function, the CED needs to buy (1) and to mitigate flooding Heavy Equipment Declogger with a unit cost of Twenty Two Million Three Hundred Forty Five Thousand Pesos (Php22,345,000.00).


WHEREAS, the said purchase request by the Bids and Awards Committee is in accordance with law and is advantageous to the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City General Services Department (QC-GSD) endures the bidding of the afore-mentioned services in Quezon City.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the Honorable City Mayor of Quezon City to enter into a Contract of Agreement with the winning bidder for the purchase of a Construction and Heavy Equipment Declogger, funded under Lump Sum Appropriation (Local Risk Reduction and Management Fund) with an amount of Twenty Two Million Three Hundred Forty Five Thousand Pesos (Php22,345,000.00).
