BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to enjoin, as it sloes hereby enjoin, all the barangays in Quezon City to plant a tree every ten meters in the areas adjacent to the streets, both business and residential, within their territorial jurisdiction.
