**A RESOLUTION ENJOINING ALL THE BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY TO PLANT A TREE EVERY TEN METERS IN THE AREA ADJACENT TO THE STREETS, BOTH BUSINESS AND RESIDENTIAL, WITHIN THEIR TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION.**

*WHEREAS trees provide oxygen that controls air pollution, thus, it is imperative that we promote awareness of its importance;*

*WHEREAS, there is a need for collaboration between city government, the barangays, and its constituents to rejuvenate the environment by undertaking extensive tree-planting in every available and suitable area, and providing effective measures for their maintenance and sustainability;*

*WHEREAS, even as our environment is crying out for our care and attention, the irresponsible and wanton destruction and cutting of trees have largely contributed to the deterioration and degradation of our environment;*

*WHEREAS, in the face of the ominous threat of the destructive effects of climate change in our midst, there is an imperative need for pro-active and dedicated effort to ensure urban greenery as an antidote to massive flooding, landslides, and other destructive effects of nature;*


*WHEREAS, being in the frontline of the government bureaucracy, our barangays play a vital role in mobilizing resources—both human and financial—towards spearheading massive tree-planting in their respective areas to ensure a safe and healthful environment for the present and future generations, thus making Quezon City a better place to live in.*

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED,** to enjoin, as it does hereby enjoin, all the barangays in Quezon City to plant a tree every ten meters in the areas adjacent to the streets, both business and residential, within their territorial jurisdiction.

**RESOLVED, FURTHER,** to direct the Barangay Operations Center to facilitate the dissemination of this Resolution to all the barangays.


