RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6178** S-2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO PURCHASE ONE (1) UNIT OF MOBILE COMPUTER VEHICLE INTENDED FOR THE DISTRICT PROJECT OF THE OFFICE OF COUNCILOR MELENCIO T. CASTELO, JR., TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes the importance of education in the development and progress of a community; as such, the city provides sufficient funds for education and encourages Quezon City residents to be diligent and persevering in their studies;

WHEREAS, one of the district projects of the Office of Councilor Melencio T. Castelo, Jr. is to train the residents of District 6 in information technology (IT);

WHEREAS, the residents of District 6 can more readily avail of IT education by means of a Mobile Computer Vehicle;

WHEREAS, as stated in Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor, as the Chief Executive of the City Government, shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the City Council, or pursuant to law and ordinance.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to purchase one (1) unit of Mobile Computer Vehicle intended for the district project of the Office of Councilor Melencio T. Castelo, Jr. to be charged against any available funds of the Office of the City Mayor.


