RESOLUTION NO. SP- 6202 , S-21/5

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH THE REGISTERED OWNER OF A PARCEL OF LAND LOCATED AT BARANGAY PASONG TAMO COVERED BY TRANSFER CERTIFICATE OF TITLE MUMBER 004-2010000300, IDENTIFIED AS LOT NO. 715-A-5 (LRC) PSD-11798 WITH GROSS AREA OF FOUR THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SEVEN SQUARE METERS AND SIXTY SQUARE DECIMETERS (4,007.60 SQ. M.), MORE OR LESS, TO BE UTILIZED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PASONG TAMO HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the City Mayor to represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or parsuant to law or Ordinance as may be found in Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 10533 or the Enhanced Basic Education Act strengthened the education curriculum and increased the years of basic education from 10 years to 22 years, adding a 2-year Senior High School Program;

WHEREAS, over 30,000 students are projected to enroll in Grade 11 in 2076 that will double as students continue on to Grade 12. To accommodate these new enrollees and decongest existing schools, there is a need to construct new high school buildings; //

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WHEREAS, the City Planning and Development Office has identified the four thousand two hundred seven square meters and sixty square decimeters (4,207.60 sq. m.) land with Lot No. 715-A-5 (LRC) Psd-11798 located at Brgy. Pasong Tamo covered by Transfer Certificate of Title Number 004-2010000300 owned by EJ Realty as a possible site for the construction of Pasong Tamo High School;

WHEREAS, a Letter of Intent to Sell was issued on January 8, 2014 by the authorized representative of the owner;

WHEREAS, the Division of City Schools - Quezon City has inspected and fuvorably indorsed the said site;

WHEREAS, the acquisition of the said site for the construction of Pasong Tamo High School will help in the successful implementation of the Senior High School Program.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista to negotiate and enter into contract with the registered owner of a parcel of land located at Barangay Pasong Tamo covered by Transfer Certificate of Title Number 004-2010000300, identified as Lot No. 715-A-5 (LRC) Psd-11798 with gross area of four thousand two hundred seven square meters and sixty square decimeters (4,207.60 sq.m.), more or less, to be utilized for the construction of Pasong Tamo High School.
