A RESOLUTION EXPRESSINC. THE HIGHEST FORM OF COMMENDATION TO THE FORTY-FOUR (44) OFFICERS AND PERSONNEL OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE SPECIAL ACTION FORCE (PNP-SAF) WHO WERE KILLED IN COMBAT IN MAMASAPANO, MAGUINDANAO DURING A LAW ENFORCEMENT OPERATION IN PURSUIT OF TWO INTERNATIONAL TERRORISTS ZULKIFLI ABDHIR, BETTER KNOWN AS MARWAN, AND ABDULBASIT USMAN.

WHEREAS, on 25 January 2015, Sunday morning, some of the 392 PMP-SAF troopers entered the territory of the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) and Bangsamoro Islamic Freedom Fighters (BIFF) to serve arrest warrants to the two international terrorists, Malaysian Jemaah Islamiyah leader Zullofli Abdhir, also known as Marwan, and Filipino bomb maker, Abdulbasit Usman;

WHEREAS, the PNP-SAF's 84th Seaborn Battalion, the elite force's but of the best had already neutralized "Mike one" - their code for Marwan and was attempting their exit at around 7 a.m. when the 55th company of the 5th action battalion was assaulted by BIFF; **

WHEREAS, several hours after, forty-four (44) officers and personnel of the PNP-SAF were killed in exchange for lasting peace. Whereby, President Benigno Simeon Aquino III had declared January 30 as a National Day of Mourning to honor the fallen officers pursuant to Proclamation No. 953, Series of 2015;
