RESOLUTION NO. SP- 6221, S-2014

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING ALL SUBDIVISION HOMEOWNERS IN QUEZON CITY TO REQUIRE ALL MOTORCYCLE DRIVERS AND PASSENGER(S) TO REMOVE THEIR HELMETS AND/OR ANYTHING THAT WOULD CONCEAL THEIR IDENTITIES UPON REACHING THE GATE OF THE PREMISES.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10054, otherwise known as the "Motorcycle Helmet Act of 2009," and Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2244, S-2013, otherwise known as the "Ordinance Strictly Implementing the maximum allowable speed limit in all subdivision in Quezon City, as set forth by R.A. No. 4136 and Ordinance No. SP-1444, S-2004, otherwise known as the Traffic Management Code of Quezon City, apprehending and penalizing violations thereof," have been enacted to prevent accidents and to protect motorist from harm and injuries in case of accidents;

WHEREAS, crime committed by riding in tandem is currently the most controversial and frustrating problem in our society;

WHEREAS, some subdivisions have CCTV cameras which are installed at the gate therein;

WHEREAS, those motorists and/or passengers with helmet, etc., are unrecognizable by the CCTV cameras; y

WHEREAS, criminals are taking advantage of wearing helmets to commit crimes and to conceal their identities, to easily escape from criminal liability in case of doubt;

WHEREAS, there's a need to enact a law which seeks to prevent criminals from committing crimes and this will be done by making all subdivisions in Quezon City to require all motorcycle drivers and passengers(s) to remove their helmets and/or anything that could conceal their identities upon reaching the gate of the premises;


WHEREAS, the driver and its passenger(s) are required to remove their helmets at the gate of the subdivision for them to expose their faces or to be identified by the security guards and CCTV cameras; and

WHEREAS, the City Government is mandated by law to promulgate an ordinance or resolution that seeks to protect and promote the welfare of the people.


NOW, THEREFORE,


