RESOLUTION NO. SP- 6225 , S-2014

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE CONTRACT ENTERED INTO BY THE HONORABLE QUEZON CITY MAYOR HERBERT M. BAUTISTA WITH THE WINNING BIDDERS FOR THE VARIOUS INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS IN QUEZON CITY IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED TWENTY THREE MILLION THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FORTY THREE PESOS AND FIFTY CENTAVOS (PHP223,366,543.50).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to ratify, as it does hereby ratify the contract entered into by the Honorable Quezon City Mayor Herbert M. Bautista with the winning bidders for the various infrastructure projects in Quezon City in the total amount of Two Hundred Twenty Three Million Three Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Forty Three Pesos and Fifty Centavos (PHP223, 366, 543.50).

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be given to the City Budget Department, City Accounting Department, City Engineering Department, Commission on Audit-Quezon City Field Office, and Department of Interior and Local Government for their information and guidance.
