RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6236**, S-2015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE PHILIPPINE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY-QUEZON CITY (PCCI-QC) REPRESENTED BY ITS PRESIDENT, DR. CARL E. BALITA, FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT, MANAGEMENT, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE QUEZON CITY BUSINESS REGISTRY DATABANK TO BE LOCATED AT ALI MALL GOVERNMENT CENTER, ARANETA CENTER, CUBAO, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry – Quezon City (PCCI-QC) is the local chamber of business people and entrepreneurs of Quezon City. It is under the auspices of the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry (PCCI), which is recognized as the "single voice of business" in the Philippines. As such, the PCCI-QC was instrumental in making Quezon City a Hall of Fame Awardee as the Most Business-Friendly City of the country by the PCCI;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-1429, S-2004 officially created the Quezon City Business Registry Databank (QCBRD), whereby the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry has been designated as the principal communication line of the Quezon City Government to the business community;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-1429, S-2004 was later amended by Ordinance No. SP-2035, S-2010 and now made to read as follows:

"Section 2. Mandate- (b) And in order to facilitate effective communication, improve business information data, rationalize business zoning and keep track of business development, a business registry databank hereinafter to be known as the "Quezon City Business Registry Databank" is hereby established to be operated and maintained by the Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) in partnership with the Quezon City Chamber of Commerce and Industry (QCCCI)":

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-2035, S-2010 further provides in Section 3 thereof that the City shall manage the funds and administer the process for the procurement of the needed software and equipment. Likewise, the City, in coordination with PCCI-QC, shall be responsible for the determination of the actual content of the portal, design of the project, and maintenance of all the records and contents for the procurement of the needed software and equipment through a Memorandum of Agreement duly certified by the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, Ordinance Nos. SP-1429 and SP-2035 did not specify where the abovementioned QCBRD shall be located, hence, there is a need for the City government and PCCI-QC to identify and reach an agreement where it would be established, including its management, operation and maintenance;

WHEREAS, on 29 September 2014, the Department of Trade and Industry National Capital Regional Office (DTI-NCRO) and Araneta Center, Incorporated (ACI) entered into a Memorandum of Agreement, wherein ACI provided DTI-NCRO an office space, free of rent, with a floor area of approximately 82 sq.m. located at Ali Mall Government Center, Level 2 (3rd Floor), Araneta Center, Cubao, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, on the same date (29 September 2014), the DTI-NCR and PCCI-QC entered into a Memorandum of Agreement for the implementation of the Shared Service Facility Project of the DTI. Pursuant thereto, DTI-NCR has identified PCCI-QC as a qualified "Cooperator" under Section 5.2.2 or 5.2.3 of Memorandum Order No. 13-1627, Series of 2013 to manage a Shared Service Facility for Business Resource and Innovation Center to be established at Level 2 (3rd Floor), Ali Mall Government Center, Araneta Center, Cubao, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the establishment of the QCBRD in Ali Mall and simultaneous operation of Business Resource and Innovation Center by the DTI-NCR, through the PCCI-QC, is not only advantageous to the City Government in terms of resources but more importantly, it will better serve the business community in Quezon City; X




WHEREAS, the proposed Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) shall form an integral part of this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to negotiate and enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry-Quezon City (PCCI-QC) represented by its President, Dr. Carl E. Balita, for the establishment, management, operation and maintenance of the Quezon City Business Registry Databank to be located at Ali Mall Government Center, Araneta Center Cubao, Quezon City.


