A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE SOCIALIZED HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION (SHFC) FOR ADOPTING HIGH DENSITY HOUSING PROGRAM FINANCING TO ADDRESS HOMELESSNESS OF INFORMAL SETTILER FAMILIES LIVING IN WATERWAYS AND OTHER HIGH RISK-DANGER AREAS IN METRO MANILA.
