A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE HONORABLE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, BROTHER ARMIN A. LUISTRO, FSC, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITIONAL SCHOOL BUILDING IN JUDGE FELICIANO BELMONTE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY HOLY SPIRIT, QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the City Council shall urge the Department of Education for the construction of additional school building in Judge Feliciano Belmonte Senior High School in Barangay Holy Spirit, Quezon City, under the Basic Education Facilities Fund (BEFF) of the Department of Education;

WHEREAS, the implementation of K+12 Basic Education Program and the rapid growth in the number of new enrollees in said school has created a shortage of classrooms and school facilities, therefore there is a need to provide for additional building for those purposes;

WHEREAS, education is a major investment that the government can make for the future of the people, and a vital component in reducing poverty and inequality;

WHEREAS, as of June 2014, Judge Feliciano Belmonte, Sr. High School has 5,307 enrollees and the proposed school building project shall be a four-(4) storey, sixteen-(16) classroom building and a four-(4) storey, eight-(8) classroom building for the accommodation and convenience of the students;

WHEREAS, Judge Feliciano Belmonte Sr. High School shall prioritize the enrolment and acceptance of students residing in District II, Quezon City.


NOW, THEREFORE,
