WHEREAS, Ms. Ruiz was featured in Forbes' list of 30 Under 30, A magazine which publishes an annual list of the world's wealthiest individuals, featuring 30 successful entrepreneurs under 30 years of age, in Social Entrepreneurship category in 2015;

WHEREAS, Rags2Riches is the first fashion and design house empowering community artisans in the Philippines and chosen women in Barangay Payatas, Quezon City to be part of her workforce because of their dedication and commitment to fight poverty;

WHEREAS, through Rags2Riches, Ms. Ruiz taught the women in Barangay Payatas to earn a living by turning scrap fabric materials into marketable items such as fashion handbags, eyeglass cases and wine bottles;

WHEREAS, Forbes said that Rags2Riches showed a consistent 100% annual growth rate for its first five years from 2007 to 2012;
