RESOLUTION NO. SP- **6306**, S-2015

*A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE METROPOLITAN MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (MMDA) TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF ALL MOTOR VEHICLES TRAVELING ALONG CENTRAL AVENUE (FROM VISAYAS AVENUE TO COMMONWEALTH AVENUE), QUEZON CITY AT A MAXIMUM SPEED OF SIXTY KILOMETERS PER HOUR (60KPH) AND TO IMPLEMENT RULES ON NO PARKING ON BOTH SIDES AND A TOW-AWAY ZONE, AND TO IMPOSE TRAFFIC FINES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.*

*WHEREAS, due to limited number of motor vehicles traveling therein, drivers of motor vehicles passing along Central Avenue tend to drive at high speed;*

*WHEREAS, there is a need to limit the speed of motor vehicles traveling along Central Avenue in order to prevent accidents particularly along residential areas and school zones located along the said thoroughfare.*




NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) to regulate the speed of all motor vehicles traveling along Central Avenue, from Visayas Avenue to Commonwealth Avenue, at maximum speed of Sixty Kilometers Per Hour (60 KPH) and to implement rules on no parking on both sides and a tow-away zone, and to impose fines for violation thereof.


