RESOLUTION NO. SP-_ 6351___, S-2015

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DISTRICT (QCPD) FOR THEIR VALIANT AND CONTINUING EFFORTS IN CURBING THE PROLIFERATION OF ILLEGAL DRUGS IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council has, on several occasions, extended commendation to its men in uniform for their astonishing feats, such as breakthrough in crime solution and efforts in curbing illegal drug trade, thereby giving relief to citizens of the city:

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Police District (QCPD) Anti-Drug Unit, under the leadership of Police Senior Superintendent Richard A. Albano, was adjudged the best performing police anti-narcotics office nationwide during the 11th Anniversary Celebration of the Philippine National Police's Anti-Illegal Drugs Special Operations Task Force last year because of its efforts in the anti-illegal drugs campaign which resulted to the confiscation of millions of pesos worth of Methamphetamine Hydrochloride, commonly known as "shabu", and the arrest of big-time drug peddlers in the country;

WHEREAS, on May 2014 the QCPD Anti-Illegal Drugs (AID), headed by Police Insp. Roberto Razon, arrested Chinese nationals Benson Lao and Benedict Ong and confiscated five (5) kilos of shabu, valued at P25 Million Pesos. In August, also of the same year, the operatives arrested Chinese Zhen Zhi Xu with ten (10) kilos of shabu with a street price of P15 Million Pesos;

WHEREAS, in that same month, the QCPD operatives arrested Harold Wilford Padilla and Arnel Ignacio while in possession of P30 Million worth of high-grade shabu, weighing about 4 kilograms. On August 25, 2014, in a buy-bust operation in Barangay West Triangle, the QCPD confiscated fifteen (15) kilos of high-grade shabu with an estimated value of P75 Million Pesos and arrested suspected known drug pushers, Grade Navalta and Anthony Pinedu:

WHEREAS, the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) has lauded QCPD, under its new District Director, Police Chief Superintendent Joel Pagdilao, for the reactivation of station-level anti-narcotics units in Quezon City, and for making an immediate impact on the campaign against illegal drugs. PDEA Director Arturo Cacdac, Jr. cited the station-level anti-illegal drugs campaign which resulted in the arrest of 162 drug pushers. 7 of whom were included in the Top 10 Watch List and the confiscation of illegal drugs with an estimated street value of P50 Million Pesos:

WHEREAS, the concerted efforts and the dedication of these police operatives to seriously address drug trafficking in the city, effectively contributed in curbing the drug menace in the country, must be recognized and commended.
