RESOLUTION NO. SP- 6352 , S-2015

*A RESOLUTION URGING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT TO PROVIDE SOCIAL FUND FOR QUALIFIED URBAN POOR FAMILIES AFFECTED BY ADMINISTRATIVE DEMOLITION AND EVICTION ACTIVITIES, IN THE ABSENCE OF RELOCATION SITE.*

*WHEREAS, the local government of Quezon City has a socialized housing program for legitimate and qualified urban poor families within its territory being implemented through phases in partnership with Habitat for Humanity Philippines, Gawad Kalinga, other builders, and social development organizations. However, administrative demolition and eviction affecting homeless and underprivileged families come unexpectedly, and outside the approved budget of the City—resulting to social dysfunctions and physical displacement, among others;*

*WHEREAS, Section 28 (8) of Republic Act No. 7279 provides that in cases of eviction and demolition pursuant to a court order involving underprivileged and homeless citizens, relocation shall be undertaken by the local government unit concerned and the National Housing Authority with the assistance of other government agencies within forty-five (45) days from service of notice of final judgment by the court, after which period the said order shall be executed: Provided, further, That should relocation not be possible within the said period, financial assistance in the amount equivalent to the prevailing minimum daily wage multiplied by sixty (60) days shall be extended to the affected families by the local government unit concerned";*

*WHEREAS, Pre-Demolition Conference being undertaken by stakeholders and presided by the Presidential Commission for the Urban Poor (PCUP) produced positive results, such as substantial reduction of violence during the conduct of demolition and eviction activities, encouraged landowners to sell their lands to actual occupants affected by the demolition, and smooth implementation of dismantling of structures, among others.*


*NOW, THEREFORE,*

*BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge the Quezon City Government to provide for social fund for qualified urban poor families affected by administrative demolition and eviction activities in the absence of relocation site.*


