WHEREAS, the Quezon City government pursuant to its objective of providing a clean and green environment to its constituents and of affording them and the general public a venue where they can relax and enjoy Philippine flora, especially its endemic orchids, have agreed to put up and develop a sustainable, well-maintained and fascinating orchidarium and botanical garden at the Quezon City Hall lagoon area, located along Elliptical Road, Diliman,
