BAUTISTA, TO PURCHASE ONE (1) UNIT OF MOTOR VEHICLE INTENDED FOR MONITORING OF PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS OF THE OFFICE OF COUNCILOR JESSICA CASTELO DAZA AMOUNTING TO ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNRED EIGHTY THOUSAND PESOS (P1,880,000.00) TO BE CHARGED TO THE FUNDS OF THE OFFICE OF THE SAID CITY COUNCILOR.***

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Quezon City Government, through the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, to purchase one (1) unit of motor vehicle intended for monitoring purposes of the Office of Councilor Jessica Castelo Daza, City Councilor, 4<sup>th</sup> District, Quezon City, amounting to One Million Eight Hundred Eighty Thousand Pesos (P1,880,000.00) to be charged to the funds of the Office of the said City Councilor.
