A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO PURCHASE THIRTY SEVEN (37) UNITS OF MOTORCYCLE WITH SIDECAR INTENDED FOR BARANGAY BPSO PATROL VEHICLE, UNDERTAKEN BY THE OFFICE OF DISTRICT I COUNCILOR, HONORABLE ALEXIS R. HERRERA, TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR.

WHEREAS, the purchase of motorcycle with sidecar is vital in the delivery of community-based services in each barangay which could be used for security and transportation of senior citizens and persons with disabilities;

WHEREAS, the delivery of basic services will be most effective if there are available small vehicles such as a Barangay BPSO Patrol nearest the target communities;

WHEREAS, in District I, Quezon City, there is a need to provide for motorcycles with sidecar to serve as Barangay BPSO Patrol, for the purpose of assisting the barangays in the maintenance of public order and security, among others;

WHEREAS, through the initiative of the Office of Councilor Alexis R. Herrera, the city government is requesting for the purchase of thirty seven (37) motorcycles with sidecar intended for Barangay BPSO Patrol with the following specifications:
